### ACTION

- ADOPT Resolution No. 68, approving the proposed District budget for FY 2020/21 and ordering a hearing, and
- ADOPT Resolution No. 69, adopting the District budget for FY 2020/21

### BACKGROUND

The Scottsdale Mountain Community Facilities District (CFD) was formed in 1993 to facilitate the financing, acquisition and construction of public infrastructure within the District. To date, \$5,450,000 of tax-exempt bonds were issued and are now paid in full. The District will exist until the earlier of five years with no activity (excluding administrative costs) or dissolution by the voters of the district.


The District was responsible for the installation of infrastructure, which benefits existing and future residents of the District and the City. The District has paid all debt service requirements on the bonds and therefore a tax assessment is no longer necessary.

The FY 2020/21 proposed budget (see Exhibit A of Attachment #1) has been prepared pursuant to the requirements of the Arizona Revised Statutes. The District considers anticipated administrative costs and uncollectable accounts, and may reduce cash balances as needed to comply with Arizona Revised Statutes § 35-458(A). The first Resolution calls for approval of the proposed budget and a public hearing on the proposed budget and the second Resolution adopts the budget subsequent to the hearing (see Exhibit B of Attachment #2).

### FISCAL IMPACT

The District has satisfied all debt service requirements and will no longer levy taxes from the District property owners. The proposed budget is for the District's ongoing administration expenses until dissolution of the District.

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

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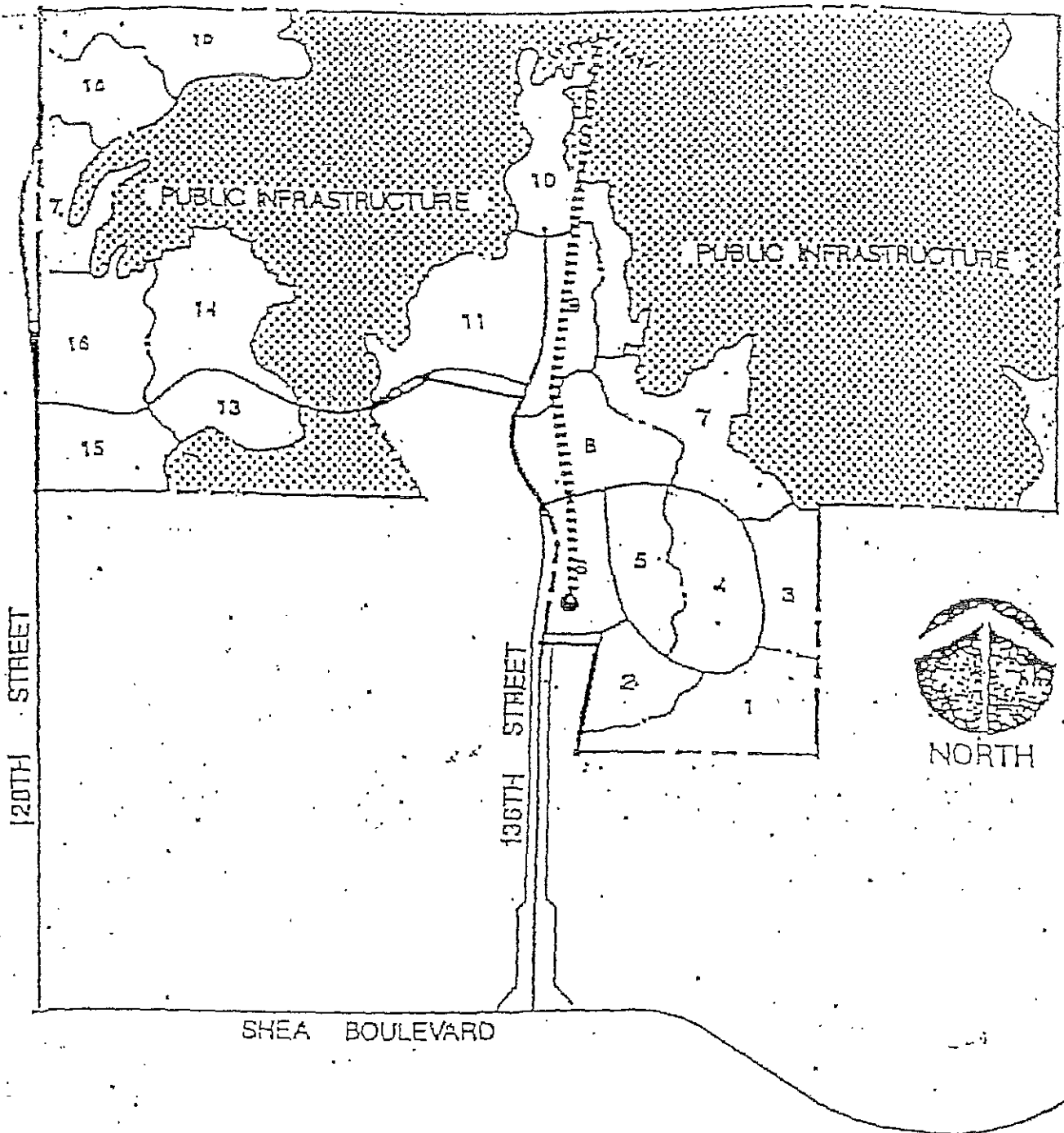


