

Need to Know – Information for Bars/Restaurants in Scottsdale

If you are considering locating a bar or restaurant in Scottsdale, it is important to be aware of city license and zoning requirements (prior to committing to a business location or submitting a liquor license application to the State.) In some instances, bars may require a Conditional Use Permit that may take 4-6 months to obtain. This handout outlines a six-step process to ensure you are fully informed/aware of the specific regulations that relate to bars/nightclubs and restaurants in Scottsdale

- 1) Identify what type of State Liquor License (Series #) you are applying for.
- 2) If you are applying for any of the following State Liquor Licenses your may also have to acquire a City of Scottsdale conditional use permit:

Series 03 – Microbrewery	Series 12 – Restaurant
Series 06 – Bar	Series 13 – Domestic Farm Winery
Series 07 – Beer & Wine Bar	Series 14 – Club (Private)

- 3) In Scottsdale, you are considered a bar/nightclub or cocktail lounge if you meet any of the following criteria:
 - o Bar service area more than 15% of the gross floor area
 - o Kitchen is less than 15% of the gross floor area
 - o Age verification is requested for admittance
 - O A cover charge is required for admittance (except for special events approved through city's special event process)
 - o Less than 40% of gross revenues are generated from the sale of prepared food
 - o The business remains open and liquor sales continue but the kitchen closes before 9 p.m.

If you checked any one of the above, you are considered a bar and may be required to obtain a conditional use permit. Proceed to step #4 for information about determining applicability. If you did not check any of the above criteria, you can proceed to step #5.

- 4) If your business meets any of the above criteria, please contact the City of Scottsdale immediately to determine applicability of the regulations and the most efficient process to meet the regulations. You may contact Eva Wallace at (480) 312-2788 to schedule an appointment. Your appointment will take place at the city's Planning & Development Services Office, located on the first floor of One Civic Center, 7447 E. Indian School Road, Suite 105. An area map is provided on the last page of this handout. You can call (480) 312-7000 for directions.
- 5) All liquor license applications in Scottsdale are required to complete the attached questionnaire (pages 2-4 of this handout) and either fax to (480) 312-7088 Attention Eva Wallace, or deliver to the first floor of One Civic Center, 7447 E. Indian School Road, Suite 105 Attention Eva Wallace. Normal business hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. An area map is provided on the last page of this handout. You can also call (480) 312-7000 for directions.
- 6) A Scottsdale (city) liquor license is also required. Contact (480) 312-2400 for application.
