Mayor Manross closed public testimony.

Chief Planning Officer Randy Grant pointed out an error in the Council Report description of the request for Item No. 11. Mr. Grant reported that the Planning Commission recommended that fifteen feet of the GLO be maintained, which reduces the abandonment request to eighteen feet along the northern property boundary.

Councilman Nelssen asked staff to address Mr. Spiro's comment regarding the abandonment on the parcel to the west. Mr. Grant responded that, to his knowledge, the case questioned by Mr. Spiro (9-AB-2005) had been approved. Mr. Grant stated that he would check on the status of Case 9-AB-2005 and provide a report of his findings.
