There were about 30 people who attended this Open House; however, only 20 signed in (see attached sign in sheets). Most of the attendees were property owners in the townhomes directly south of the proposed location for a medical marijuana dispensary. We focused our efforts on educating the public the best we could with the facts of the daily operations of this particular medical clinic. We addressed state of the art security for the clinic and surrounding area. The Applicant agreed to hire a full time security guard to be on-site 24/7 to maintain the safety of the facility and

There was a lot of opposition to the proposed use – below is a list of some of the common concerns:

- Schools in the area
- Kids hang out at the Buzzberry Juice place on corner and 7-Eleven across the street – they will be sold the drugs
- · Not in my backyard
- Not in a neighborhood locate near hospital or airpark
- Bus stop bringing in all sorts of unwanted persons into the neighborhood to buy drugs

We addressed every single concern they brought up but they remained in opposition.

Attached are various email correspondence with property owners in the neighborhoods that occurred prior to the open House.

The owner of McDonald Preschool attended. This preschool is located approximately 600 ft away - this meets the 500 ft distance separation.

Thursday, 4/21 – Rose Law Group received several phone calls from property owners who did not attend the Open House or attended but had additional questions. We talked with them at length and at the end, they still remain in opposition – Not in my backyard.

We will continue to reach out to the surrounding community in order to best educate them with all of the facts regarding our request. We will also be available for additional meetings with neighbors and HOA's to address any and all concerns.

We are writing you this letter as concerned citizens living in Scottsdale a for long time. We have received a letter from ROSE LAW GROUP (copy enclosed) in which they are applying to the City of Scottsdale in behalf of Taxonomy Healing Practices to allow the operation of a MEDICAL MARIHUANA DISPENSARY at 5900 N. Granite Rd. Ste #107 in Scottsdale.

We are extremely worried because we are homeowners in this residential area, with four schools nearby: Mohave Middle School, Saguaro High School, Kiva Blementary and a Private Elementary School in the neighborhood and this Marihuana Dispensary will attract specific Non-desirable persons to our area.

I, E. Hope M. Riveron/Gruver have experienced a similar situation when I bought a home in Miami Florida and after 6 months of the Clinic operations, we started to have home vandalisms and the Clinic's Patients were selling the marihuana to other addicts on our neighborhood streets.

I was forced to sell my home because I have a child and I did not feel safe there anymore.

We think that our children's safety and ours, are in jeopardy having a clinic of this nature in our residential area.

This type of Clinic should be situated in a Medical facility or in a Commercial-Medical area NOT IN OUR NEIGHBORHOOD WHICH IS A RESIDENTIAL AREA. WE ARE SERIOUSLY OPPOSED TO THIS TYPE OF PRACTICE IN OUR NEIGHBORHOOD.

WE BELIEVE THAT A MARIHUANA DISPENSARY WILL ATTRACT THE TYPE OF PATIENTS THAT ARE NOT THE REGULAR PATIENTS AND DESPITE OF THE ASURANCES THAT THIS LAW GROUP IS STATING IN THEIR LETTER, THIS TYPE OF PERSONS ARE NOT WHAT WE WISH OUR CHILDREN TO BE SURROUNDED BY.

WE ARE APPEALING TO YOUR HELP IN NOT GRANTING THE APPROVAL OF THIS APPLICATION.

There is absolutely NO loitering which the security guard will enforce as well as no on-site consumption of any kind. Again, this facility will operate like any other professional medical office - patients will arrive, have a quick consultation to discuss various medicinal products and then leave with their medicine. I understand that there are so many misconceptions about medical marijuana and a lot of that comes from what has and is happening in California. The voters of Arizona approved this back in November and the state and local jurisdictions have been working very hard to create strict rules and regulations in order to control this new industry. Our application meets and exceeds with all of those rules and regulations and Taxonomy Healing Practices will strive to be a good, discrete member of the community to the surrounding businesses and neighbors. Signage will be very minimal and will have no reference to marijuana - again, the only ones that will know this facility is here will be those qualified patients. There will be no advertising on site. We would like to have open communication with neighbors, such as yourself, to ensure a positive impact on the surrounding area. 
