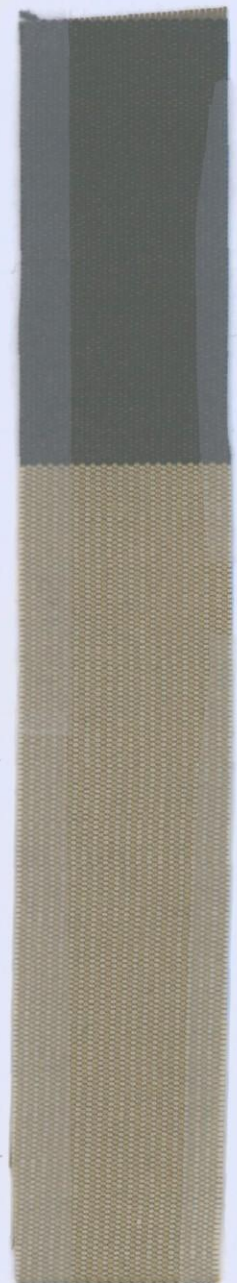

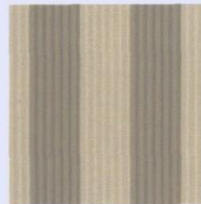

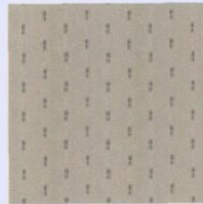

1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

1.3 DEFINITIONS

- A. **Awning:** An architectural projection that provides weather protection, identity, or decoration and is wholly supported by the building to which it is attached. An awning is comprised of a lightweight, rigid skeleton structure over which a covering is attached.

- C. **Samples for Verification:** For each exterior fabric selected or required.
- D. **Exterior Fabric Schedule:** Use designations indicated on Drawings.
- E. **Product Certificates:** Manufacturer's certification that each type of exterior fabric complies with requirements.
- F. **Maintenance and Cleaning Instructions:** Manufacturer's recommendations, including:

1. Maintenance of exterior fabrics.
2. Cleaning information and precautions for exterior fabrics.

G. Warranty: Manufacturer's standard warranty.

1.6 QUALITY ASSURANCE

A. Fabricator Qualifications: Employ workers skilled in production of custom-fabricated products similar to those required for this Project, with a record of successful performance.

Note to Specifier: Retain below for large or complex installation projects.

1. Fabricate exterior fabric products using a Master Fabric Craftsman fabricator, certified by the Industrial Fabrics Association International.

B. Source Limitations: Obtain exterior fabrics from one supplier and a single manufacturer.

Note to Specifier: Retain below if required by authorities having jurisdiction.

C. Regulatory Requirements: Provide awnings that comply with or exceed requirements of **[Insert Building Code requirements]** **[and]** **[applicable ordinances]**.

4. Width: 60 inches (152.4 cm).
5. Color Fade Resistance: UV resistant. Most colors tested up to 1500 hrs in SAE 1960J fadeometer with minimal or no change. Fade resistant to most chemicals.
6. Durability/Average Lifespan: Five to Ten years, depending upon climate and proper application of fabric.
7. Underside: Same as top surface.
8. Surface: Plain weave, breathable.
9. Transparency Level: Light colors translucent to natural and artificial light.
