
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



Scottsdale Stadium Bike Racks Cost Center: YB28A


The proposed project will increase the number of bike racks along the West and South perimeter of the Scottsdale Stadium. The existing quantity of bike racks does not meet the cyclist's demand during events. The proposed bike racks will resemble baseballs and bats and will be painted "Stadium Green" to match the existing facility. The proposed locations, identified by Scottsdale Stadium management, are in areas currently used for bicycle storage or in new areas that do not affect site circulation.




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
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


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


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




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CONSTRUCTION NOTES

- Area 1. Replace existing bike racks with new, single row of 8 ball/bat bike racks. Install new racks within existing brick boundary (same as existing footprint).

 Area 2. Install new row of 8 ball/bat bike racks. Install new racks within existing brick boundary.
- Area 3. Install new row of 6 ball/bat bike racks. Install new racks within existing brick boundary.
- Area 4. Install new row of 8 ball/bat bike racks. Install new racks within existing brick boundary.
- SE Area 5 (East). Install 20 new racks in same location as existing racks and protect existing trees.

 SE Area 5 (East). Install 20 new row of ball/bat bike racks. Fit new racks within existing brick boundary and protect existing trees.
