Scottsdale General Plan 2014 Workshops: Neighborhoods and Housing

To encourage public involvement in the General Plan 2014 process a series of eight workshops has been scheduled from June, 2013 through February, 2014.

The first workshop is titled **Neighborhoods and Housing**. Workshop participants will be invited to evaluate and discuss:

- Neighborhoods – the one you live in and what makes it great;
- What improvements would you like to see in your neighborhood over the next ten (10) to twenty (20) years;
- Sustainable Communities; and
- The Scottsdale General Plan 2001 Neighborhoods and Housing element value statements.

Some of these value statements include:

- A broad diversity of owner-occupied and rental housing types;
- Housing that is energy efficient, environmentally sensitive, and that blends with the city's natural surroundings;
- Citizen involvement in the preservation and revitalization of Scottsdale neighborhoods;
- Redevelopment and reinvestment in the community's mature areas; and
- Preservation of the community's historic, archeological, and cultural heritage.

To allow greater flexibility for Scottsdale residents and stakeholders to attend the Neighborhood and Housing Workshop, it will be offered on two consecutive days:

- Wednesday June 19, Desert Canyon School Library, 10203 E. McDowell Mountain Ranch Road; and
- Thursday June 20, SkySong, 1475 N. Scottsdale Road, Convergence Room.

There will be two sessions for each workshop. They will be from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 6 to 9 p.m. The same material and topics will be discussed at both sessions.

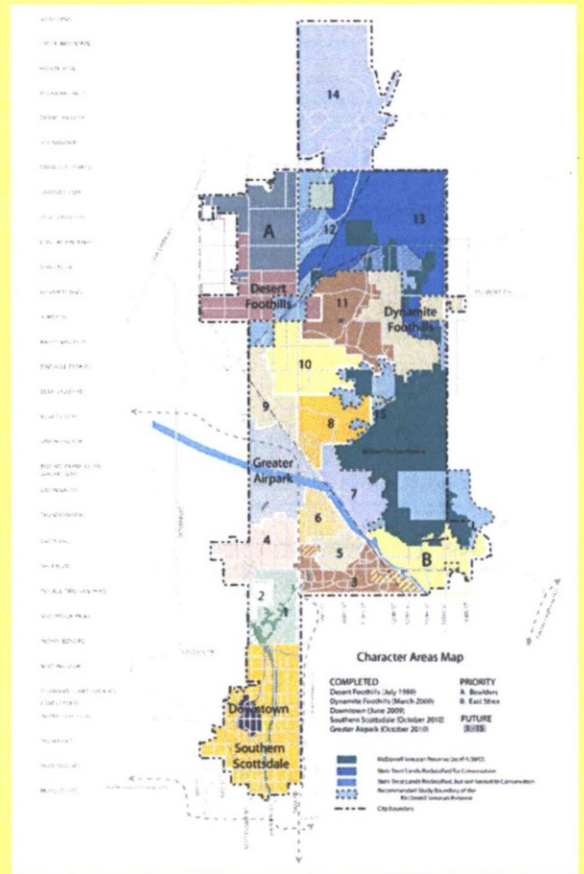

Walk. Bike. Drive. Fly. Ride. No matter how you get here, we need you to join the conversation!

What do you think about transit in Scottsdale? Does the city provide adequate support for biking and walking? How does growing traffic congestion affect quality of life?

These are just some of the important discussions that will take place at a pair of “café conversations” that are part of the General Plan 2014 process.

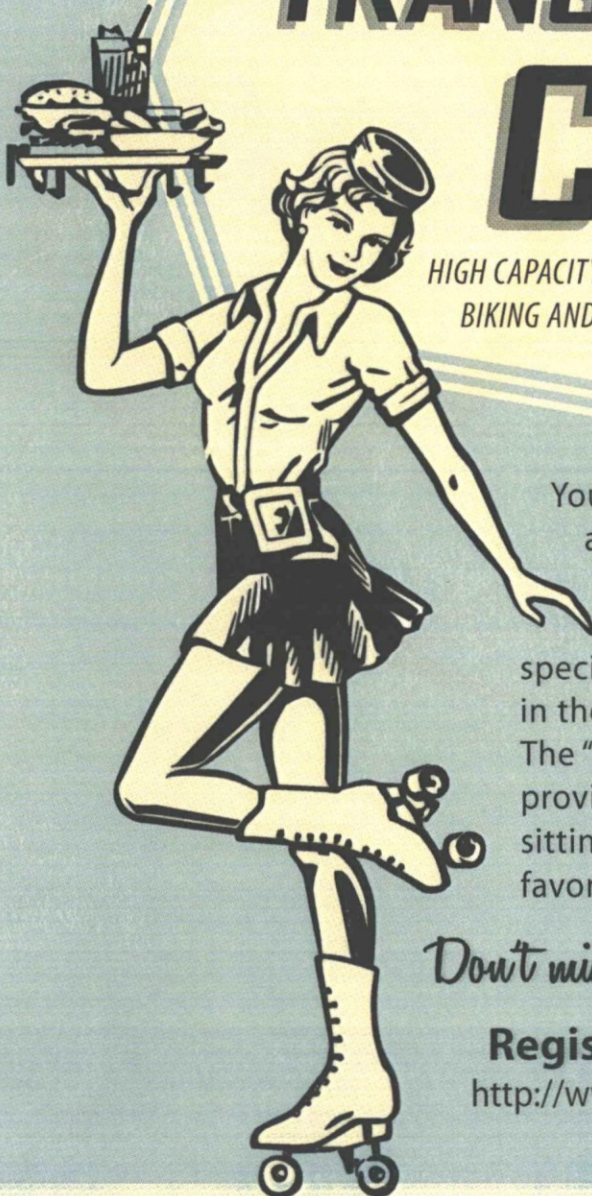

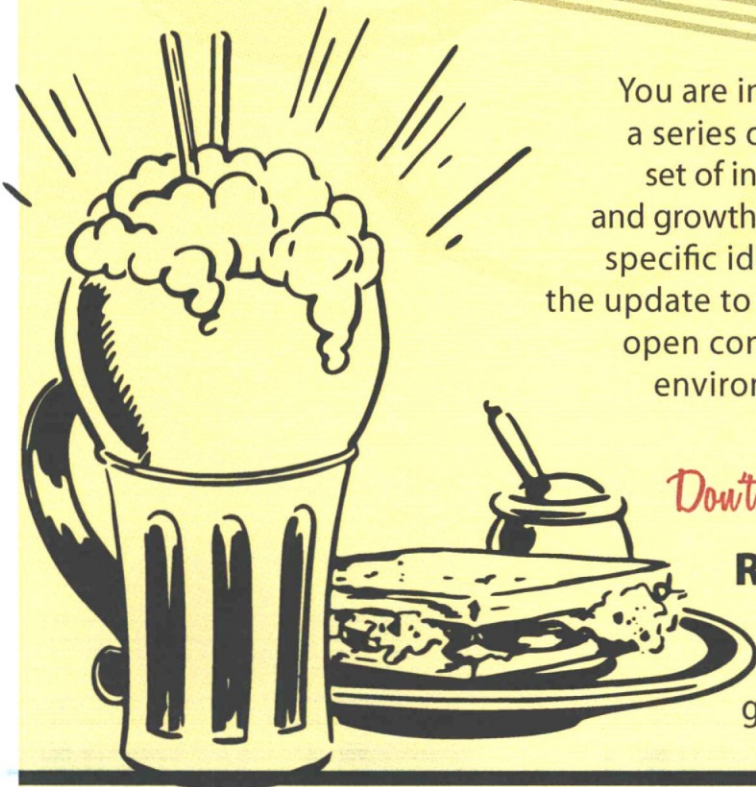

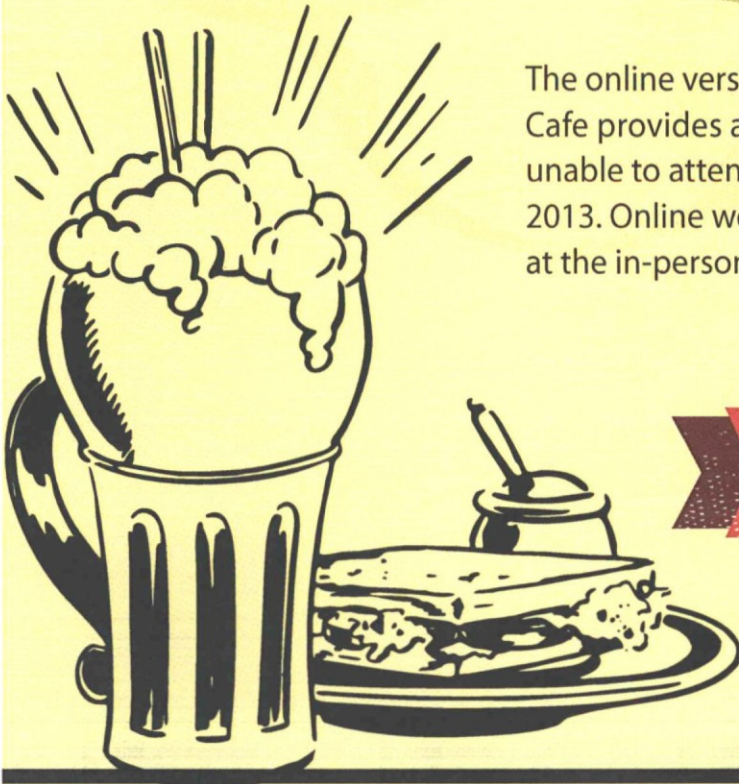

Comment on land use and general plan amendment criteria at final in series of 2014 General Plan Workshops

Scottsdale residents will be asked to consider two issues relating to future land use at a pair of public workshops as part of the 2014 General Plan process. Two sessions will be held on Thursday, Nov. 14 – noon to 2:30 p.m. and 5:30 to 8 p.m. in SkySong's Ingenuity Room, 1475 N. Scottsdale Road.

Participants will be asked to provide input on the city's land use plan, a central component of the Scottsdale General Plan. The land use plan identifies locations and types of land uses that currently exist and are anticipated in the future. These include uses for residential, commercial, industrial, resort/tourism and open space. In addition, attendees also will be asked to weigh-in on the criteria that determine the public process for amending the land use plan and other parts of the General Plan.

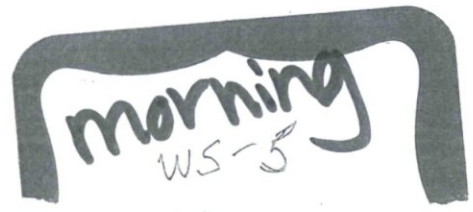

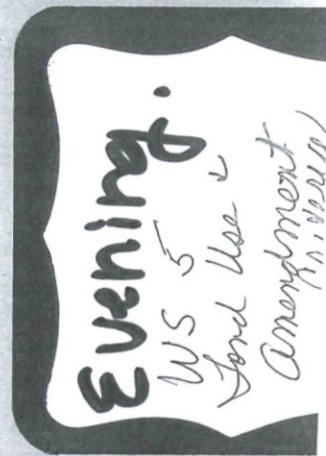
