- 1. Continuous Shade canopy on west elevation for pedestrians, hotel entry and drop-off
- 2. Covered Dining patio on southwest corner to continue and enhance pedestrian streetscape
- 3. Recessed ground floor to provide shade for pedestrians and hotel lobby
- 4. Percentage of glass less than 50% overall
- 5. Glass distributed based on solar orientation, less glass on south, east and west.
- 6. 35% of glass on south and east elevations. 5% reduction less than 40% recommended by IgCC.
- 14" Floor slab extension shade devices on west, east and south elevations to provide solar protection
- 8. 14" Vertical shade devices on west elevation
- 9. 24" recessed glazing on top two floors of south elevation
- 10. Enhanced paving to further improve pedestrian experience
- 11. Art in ROW to enhance pedestrian experience
- 12. Visually open 2-3 story hotel lobby with sculptural stair to engage pedestrian environment
- 13. Indoor / Outdoor planters to engage pedestrian environment
- 14. Recessed 3rd floor dining patio to visibly engage streetscape
- 15. Balconies on northeast and northwest to provide shade and architectural detail
- 16. Recessed penthouse amenity
- 17. High end materials metal panels, glass, concrete, wood
- 18. Wall Mural Art incorporated into elevation
