We want a comfortable experience for our transit riders and I think that the existing location is in the best spot however I don't believe this is a busy transfer location and I don't think this particular stop is used as much as others in similar circumstances. Looking towards the future and maybe having Scottsdale Road as a Bus Rapid Transit corridor I think that it might be a good idea to have a bus bay and if that requires moving the stop location slightly further north I think it is a good trade off. It is also my understanding that there might be some future high density residential/hotel at 3rd Ave that could generate transit usage so moving the stop north could also benefit those potential future users. I am good with either option but For the sake of traffic issues and safety of loading transit users onto the buses it is a good idea to have a bus pullout there.
