SCOTTSDALE PROJECT UPDATE



Come View Plans for New Fire Station & Well Site in Your Neighborhood

The City of Scottsdale will be building a new fire station and well site in the community. Come learn more about both projects at a public meeting at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, Nov. 28 at the TPC Clubhouse Thunderbird Room, 17020 N. Hayden Rd., Scottsdale.

Fire Station 612 was approved by Scottsdale voters in the 2019 bond election and is needed to improve response times in the area. The 12,000-square-foot fire station will be constructed at the northeast corner of Hayden Rd. and Mayo Blvd. Construction is expected to being in late 2023 and take approximately a year to complete. Scottsdale Water will construct a new Aquifer Storage and Recovery Well next to the fire station, maximizing the city's commitment to renewable surface water supplies. Construction of a 24 ft. sound-wall to minimize noise and light pollution to residents is underway. Drilling of the well will begin in early December and continue 24/7 to ensure well integrity and to prevent collapse. Phase one of construction is anticipated to last up to four months; phase two will start up to a year later with the building of a well structure, wall and landscaping around the site.
