The specific request is to update the allowed use list within the PCP subdistrict, Airpark Mixed Use (AMU). The AMU subdistrict allows for office uses by right. However, a footnote limits the office uses to a maximum of 50% of the ground floor building area of the Development Plan. This requires offsetting non-office square footage to develop on the property's ground floor square footage. In an effort to build a project that allows 100% of the ground floor building area to be office uses, we are requesting a minor text amendment to remove the 50% limitation footnote.
