Vice-Chairman Jones expressed concern about the use of Muhlenbergia Capillaris 'Regal Mist' grass, which tends to spread uncontrollably and is in many areas not allowed. Mr. Epstein agreed that staff would review with the Applicant the appropriateness of the grass material for the area.

Chase Bank

In response to a question by Vice-Chairman Jones, Mr. Williams clarified that the majority of the landscaping would be installed as part of the larger project; the application included minimal landscaping as part of the bank project.

VICE-CHAIRMAN JONES MOVED FOR APPROVAL OF CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS 118-DR-1999#6, 135-DR-2006, AND 91-DR-2005#2. BOARD MEMBER BRANTNER SECONDED THE MOTION.

Mr. Jeffery Mangers, resident of Camelview Greens located on the southwest corner of Indian Bend and Hayden, voiced opposition to the Indian Bend Road Improvements. He felt the project should be rejected because the City was spending money to improve an area that would strictly benefit people accessing the 101 and not the Scottsdale taxpayers. He inquired whether the project would increase the downstream flood levels.

Mr. Randall Beck with URS Corporation, consultant for the City on the Indian Bend Road project, indicated that there would be no significant increase in flood levels as a result of the project.
