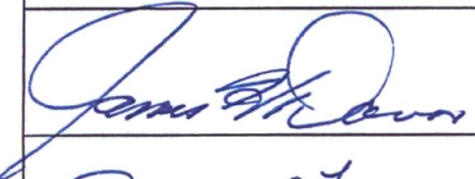
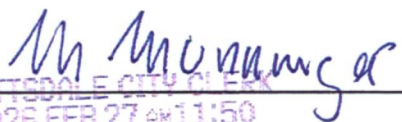

Scottsdale City Charter Article Two § 15. mandates that "Any citizen of the city may appear before the council AT any regular meeting and PRESENT a written petition"; and that "SUCH PETITION SHALL BE ACTED UPON BY THE COUNCIL, IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF BUSINESS, WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS."

The council's rules of procedure violates the Charter in requiring citizens to submit petitions two-business-days in advance of a council meeting, and by also allowing the council to outrageously dodge acting on "Citizen Petitions" by "directing the City Manager or other responsible Charter Officer to investigate the matter and prepare a written response to Council with a copy to the petitioner", thus, avoiding Charter's requirement for the council to act "in the regular course of business, within thirty (30) days" as required by the charter.

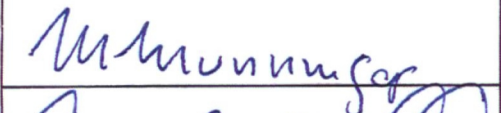
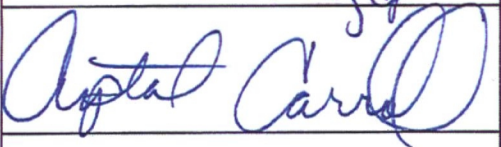
