January 9, 2024 *Public Services and Facilities Provide Services to improve neighborhoods and the lives of Scottsdale Residents.*

ACTION

Job Order Contracting (JOC) Construction Services Contract One-year Extensions for Citywide General Landscape Construction Services. Adopt Resolution 13020 authorizing Contract 2020-004-COS-A3 with DBA Construction, Inc., Contract 2020-005-COS-A3 with Landscapes Unlimited, LLC and Contract 2020-019-COS-A3 with Valley Rain Construction Corporation for one-year contract extensions for citywide general landscape construction services.

BACKGROUND

The purpose of this action is to authorize the third year of three possible option years allowed under the terms of the City's currently active Citywide General Landscape Construction Services Job Order Contracts (JOC) with DBA Construction, Inc., Landscapes Unlimited LLC and Valley Rain Construction Corporation.

The citywide landscape Job Order contracts will support the City's need for small landscape projects which may include features such as: installation of plants, trees and irrigation systems; plant inventory and native plant salvage services; installation of walkways or fencing related to landscape or park improvements; installation of basic landscape lighting and associated electrical; grading and excavation for landscaping purposes; and construction management.

Since approval of these contracts in January 2020, DBA Construction, Landscapes Unlimited and Valley Rain Construction have provided timely, high quality, and cost-effective construction for the City on a number of projects. These have included the Peaceful Valley Monument Repair, the Pima Park Restroom Replacement and the Scottsdale Road Median Landscape.

The maximum annual aggregate limit of \$2,000,000 per contract is consistent with anticipated requirements that would be suitable for execution using these contracts over the next year.

ANALYSIS & ASSESSMENT

Community Involvement

City Staff will continue to use the same community involvement and notification procedures for job orders issued under this contract that are used when projects are constructed using other procurement methods, in order to meet the needs of residents and businesses throughout the project areas.

RESOURCE IMPACTS

Available funding

Authorization of this contract modification commits no funding. Funding for each job order will be provided by the individual CIP project associated with the scope of the task and will be encumbered once negotiations are completed.

Staffing, Workload Impact

Existing Capital Project Management staff resources are available to provide design and construction contract administration, construction management and inspection services for these projects. Melanie Gibson, Public Works Project Coordinator in the Capital Project Management Division of the Public Works Department, is the contract administrator for this contract.

Future Budget Implications

Combined construction cost for all projects will not exceed \$2,000,000 per contract annually. There is no additional operating budget required as a result of this contract.

OPTIONS & STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Recommended Approach:

Adopt Resolution 13020 authorizing Contract 2020-004-COS-A3 with DBA Construction, Inc., Contract 2020-005-COS-A3 with Landscapes Unlimited LLC and Contract 2020-019-COS-A3 with Valley Rain Construction Corporation for one-year contract extensions for citywide general landscape construction services.

Proposed Next Steps:

If this action is approved, staff will immediately begin considering the use of these contracts as an alternative for landscape improvement projects as appropriate.

WHEREAS, this extension is for the third of three (3) possible one-year extensions, after the completion of the original two-year term; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that DBA Construction, Inc., Landscapes Unlimited, LLC and Valley Rain Construction Corporation are qualified to render the services desired by the City and have rendered satisfactory services under the existing contract.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Scottsdale as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute Contract No. 2020-004-COS-A3 with DBA Construction, Inc., Contract 2020-005-COS-A3 with Landscapes Unlimited, LLC and Contract No. 2020-019-COS-A3 with Valley Rain Construction Corporation for a one-year time extension, not to exceed \$2,000,000 per each Contract for landscaping services throughout the City as needed.
