- 2. City Manager or designee(s) to conduct all negotiations and to execute and submit all documents and other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with the acceptance of the grant; and
- 3. A budget transfer up to \$25,000 from the Fiscal Year 2023/24 Future Grants Budget and/or Grant Contingency Budget to a newly created cost center to record the related grant activity, if awarded.

BACKGROUND

The Scottsdale Police Department (Department) has a strong partnership with the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) with both department's striving to maintain safe streets. One area of focus for GOHS includes encouraging motorists to find an alternate mode of transportation when they are under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol and removing those drivers who choose to drive while under the influence from the streets. Scottsdale is not only host to many high-profile events such as the Barrett-Jackson Auto Auction, the Waste Management Phoenix Open, Major League Baseball Cactus League spring training, and the Arabian Horse Show, it is also host to the largest entertainment district in the state with over 400 establishments that serve alcohol in a very small area. Even with the increase in Uber and Lyft drivers, some visiting the entertainment district and/or attending an event still chose to operate a motor vehicle after consuming alcohol and/or drugs, posing a risk to themselves and others.

Scottsdale's unique Downtown Entertainment District draws a large number of people from all over the Valley and creates an environment where roadways become congested from both vehicles and pedestrians. Often, drivers and pedestrians are impaired by either alcohol, drugs, or both. The Scottsdale Police Departments continually looks for innovative techniques to achieve the goal of "Enhancing Traffic Safety". The extremely successful Know Your Limit program is one example of this unique and innovative strategies that department has implemented.

ANALYSIS & ASSESSMENT

The agency goals over the course of the grant period will be to conduct saturation patrols and participate in numerous DUI Task force operations to bring awareness to and enforce DUI traffic laws. The goal is to reduce impaired driving crashes by 10%, serious injury collisions by 10%, and the number of fatal collisions by 50%.

Available funding

Grant funds will reimburse the city for overtime costs related to targeted driving under the influence education and enforcement details, including up to 40% of the employee related fringe benefits. Funding for the 60% remaining related benefit expenses is included in the FY2023/24 Public Safety – Police Division's operating budget.

Staffing, Workload Impact

Approval of the grant will allow the Traffic Unit to conduct additional targeted enforcement and education details.
