# **ACTION**

**One-Year Contract Extensions for On-Call Mechanical Engineering Services.** Adopt Resolution 13088 authorizing On-Call Contract No. 2021-047-COS-A2 between the City and Energy Systems Design, Inc., No. 2021-048-COS-A2 between the City and LSW Engineers Arizona, Inc. and No. 2021-049-COS-A2 between the City and Pearson Engineering Associates, Inc., for one-year contract extensions for Mechanical Engineering Services on an "as needed" basis at various project locations throughout the City of Scottsdale.

# BACKGROUND

The purpose of this action is to authorize the second of three possible option years allowed under the terms of the City's currently active on-call engineering services contracts with Energy Systems Design, Inc., LSW Engineers Arizona, Inc. and Pearson Engineering Associates, Inc.

The original contracts were for two years, with the option to extend for up to three additional oneyear periods, upon satisfactory completion of the engineering services. The use of these types of contracts allows the City to engage the services of the most qualified engineering firm to design and plan multiple projects in a cost effective and efficient manner.

Since approval of the initial Mechanical On-Call Engineering Services contracts in May 2021, Energy Systems Design, Inc., LSW Engineers Arizona, Inc. and Pearson Engineering Associates, Inc. have provided timely, high-quality designs for the City on a number of projects. These have included the PD/Fire Headquarters Chiller Replacement, the Scottsdale Artist School HVAC System Upgrades and the WestWorld Exhaust Construction Administration and Commissioning.

For larger individual projects, staff will continue to select engineers using qualification-based selection procedures and seek Council approval for individual engineering contracts.

# **ANALYSIS & ASSESSMENT**

# **Community Involvement**

Staff will continue to use the same community involvement and notification procedures for job orders issued under this contract that are used when projects are constructed using other procurement methods.

Community involvement for each individual work order will be coordinated with the sponsoring Division as design progresses.

# **RESOURCE IMPACTS**

## Available funding

Authorization of these contracts commits no funding. Funding for each job order will be provided by the individual CIP project associated with the scope of the task and will be encumbered once negotiations are completed.

# Staffing, Workload Impact

The contract administrator, responsible for enforcing all contract provisions, will be Melanie Gibson, Project Coordinator in the Capital Project Management Department of the Public Works Division. Existing Capital Project Management staff will coordinate the design work with support from the sponsoring Division.

# **Future Budget Implications**

Combined cost for all projects administered under each contract will not exceed \$750,000 annually per contract. There is no additional operating budget required as a result of this contract.

# **OPTIONS & STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

### **Recommended Approach**

Adopt Resolution 13088 authorizing three (3) Engineering Services On-Call Contract Modifications; No. 2021-047-COS-A2 between the City and Energy Systems Design, Inc., No. 2021-048-COS-A2 between the City and LSW Engineers Arizona, Inc. and No. 2021-049-COS-A2 between the City and Pearson Engineering Associates, Inc., to provide consultation, design and preparation of construction documents for Mechanical Engineering Services on an "as needed" basis at various project locations throughout the City of Scottsdale.

### **Proposed Next Steps:**

Following approval of the three (3) on-call contract modifications, individual projects identified for execution will be awarded under the terms of the contracts.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT EXTENSIONS 2021-047-COS-A2 WITH ENERGY SYSTEMS DESIGN, INC., 2021-048-COS-A2 WITH LSW ENGINEERS ARIZONA, INC. AND 2021-049-COS-A2 WITH PEARSON ENGINEERING ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR A ONE-YEAR TIME EXTENSION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$750,000 FOR MECHANICAL ON-CALL ENGINEERING SERVICES.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Scottsdale as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor of the City of Scottsdale is authorized and directed to execute engineering services Contract No. 2021-047-COS-A2 between the City and Energy Systems Design, Inc., No. 2021-048-COS-A2 between the City and LSW Engineers Arizona, Inc., and No. 2021-049-COS-A2 between the City and Pearson Engineering Associates, Inc. for a oneyear time extension, in an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000) for each individual and separate contract of professional services to provide consultation and design services on an "as needed" basis at various project locations throughout the City of Scottsdale.
