ACTION

One-Year Contract Extensions for Civil Infrastructure On-Call Inspection Services. Adopt Resolution 13113 authorizing Contracts 2020-090-COS-A3 with Consultant Engineering, Inc. and 2020-102-COS-A3 with Tristar Engineering and Management, Inc. for one-year contract extensions for on-call infrastructure inspection services, increasing the annual contract term amount from \$500,000 to \$1,500,000 per contract, and modifying the hourly rates for Consultant Engineering, Inc. and Tristar Engineering and Management in accordance with the price adjustment terms in the original contracts.

BACKGROUND

The purpose of this action is to authorize the third of three possible option years allowed under the terms of the City's currently active on-call infrastructure inspection services contracts with Consultant Engineering, Inc. and Tristar Engineering and Management, Inc.

The original contracts were for two years, with the option to extend for up to three additional one-year periods, upon satisfactory completion of the inspection services. The use of these types of contracts allows the City to engage the services of the most qualified inspection firm to provide annual services for civil infrastructure construction inspection services for capital improvement projects citywide, on an as-needed basis. These services are to be utilized to supplement existing inspections staff, if and when needed.

ANALYSIS AND ASSESMENT

Community Involvement

Staff will continue to use the same community involvement and notification procedures for job orders issued under this contract.

Community involvement for each individual work order will be coordinated with the sponsoring Division as construction progresses.

Available funding

Authorization of these contracts commits no funding. Funding for each job order will be provided by the individual CIP project associated with the scope of the task and will be encumbered once negotiations are completed.

Staffing, Workload Impact

The contract administrator, responsible for enforcing all contract provisions, will be Melanie Gibson, Project Coordinator in the Capital Project Management Department of the Public Works Division. Existing Capital Project Management staff will coordinate the inspection work with support from the sponsoring Division.

Future Budget Implications

Combined cost for all projects administered under these contracts will not exceed \$1,500,000 annually per contract. There is no additional operating budget required as a result of these contracts.

Adopt Resolution 13113 authorizing Contracts 2020-090-COS-A3 with Consultant Engineering, Inc. and 2020-102-COS-A3 with Tristar Engineering and Management, Inc. for one-year contract extensions for on-call infrastructure inspection services, increasing the annual contract term amount from \$500,000 to \$1,500,000 per contract, and modifying the hourly rates for Consultant Engineering, Inc. and Tristar Engineering and Management, Inc. in accordance with the price adjustment terms in the original contracts.

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of Scottsdale is authorized and directed to execute Contract No. 2020-090-COS-A3 between the City and Consultant Engineering, Inc. and Contract No. 2020-102-COS-A3 between the City and Tristar Engineering and Management, Inc., each for a one-year time extension with an annual contract term in an amount not to exceed One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000) for each individual and separate contract for professional services to provide inspection services on an "as needed" basis at various project locations throughout the City of Scottsdale, and each modifying the respective hourly rates for Consultant Engineering, Inc. and Tristar Engineering and Management, Inc., in accordance with the price adjustment terms in their respective contracts.
