Arizona Revised Statutes Notice

§9-834. Prohibited acts by municipalities and employees; enforcement; notice

- A. A municipality shall not base a licensing decision in whole or in part on a licensing requirement or condition that is not specifically authorized by statute, rule, ordinance or code. A general grant of authority does not constitute a basis for imposing a licensing requirement or condition unless the authority specifically authorizes the requirement or condition.
- B. Unless specifically authorized, a municipality shall avoid duplication of other laws that do not enhance regulatory clarity and shall avoid dual permitting to the maximum extent practicable.
- C. This section does not prohibit municipal flexibility to issue licenses or adopt ordinances or codes.
- D. A municipality shall not request or initiate discussions with a person about waiving that person's rights.
- E. This section may be enforced in a private civil action and relief may be awarded against a municipality. The court may award reasonable attorney fees, damages, and all fees associated with the license application to a party that prevails in an action against a municipality for a violation of this section.
- F. A municipal employee may not intentionally or knowingly violate this section. A violation of this section is cause for disciplinary action or dismissal pursuant to the municipality's adopted personnel policy.
- G. This section does not abrogate the immunity provided by section 12-820.01 or 12-820.02.

Temporary Parking Dust Plan Notes for:

Thunderbirds, Inc. / Waste Management Phoenix Open 2021 (TPC)

In addition to methods of dust control noted on the plan the following notes are incorporated with and a part of the approved Special Event Dust Control Plan dated October 5, 2013.

- 1. Although the City of Scottsdale may have agents on site from time to time to monitor the control of dust generation, Maricopa County may still enforce its jurisdiction if they determine that the City is not enforcing the dust control or track out adequately.
- 2. Parking and driving should be limited to areas stabilized by the methods described in the dust plan.
- 3, Limit points of ingress and egress to limit track out opportunities. Gravel, pavement or RAP pad should be established at ingress and egress areas adjacent to paved public roads.
- 4. Track out should be closely monitored and cleaned up immediately by regenerative air (PM-10) street sweeper. Every effort should be taken to avoid and eliminate track out onto Scottsdale & Hayden Roads.
- **5.** Final stabilization after the event should return the site to its pre-use condition. Typically a watering truck should be used to thoroughly wet the entire area surface to establish a final crust.


Traffic Note Details

- On roadways with a speed of 40 MPH or greater, all channelization devices shall be spaced at no more than 40' on taper sections and 80' on tangent sections. For roadways with a speed of 35 MPH or less, the channelization devices shall be spaced at no more than the posted speed on tapers and 2X the posted speed on tangents.
- Use Vertical Panels only within ADOT right of way.
- All advance warning signs within ADOT's right of way shall be 48" x 48" in size and all regulatory speed limit signs shall be 48" x 60".
- All advance warning signs shall be black letters on orange reflective background and all regulatory signs shall be black letters on white reflective background.
- Warning lights on all traffic control devices on ADOT right of way within the temporary traffic control zone shall be in compliance with section 6F.83 of the 2009 MUTCD and the 2011 ADOT Traffic Control Guidelines.
- An "End Road Work Thank You" shall be placed 500' downstream of the last vertical panel exiting the temporary traffic control zone.
- All conflicting signs shall be covered using an approved method that does not damage the reflective sheeting of the sign.
- The taper portion of the lane drop shall not start within the curved section of the roadway. It shall be placed in advance of the curve.
- The contractor and/or the traffic control firm shall coordinate with the transit company relating to issues with the bus stop locations and or service for bus stops within the work zone or along the transition zone.
- If the contractor is not able to provide a clear ADA compliant sidewalk path of 48" through the work zone area, the contractor shall close the sidewalk using sidewalk closure signs. A pedestrian detour route shall be established and signed accordingly.

THERMAL SCANNING

1. PEOPLE TO BE SCREENED:

- a. All individuals entering the premises, starting on Monday morning of tournament week and going through Sunday or the conclusion of the tournament.
- b. NBC will be screened separately, however all PGA TOUR Entertainment and TOUR staff entering the TV compound in a working capacity will need to go through the TOUR's screening process.

2. LOCATIONS:

- 2. Main Entrance
 - a. Expected attendance: maximum of 5,000 per day.
 - b. Specs: Designated cooling station within the Main Entrance Tent, cooling fans, thermometers and hand sanitizing stations.
- 3. Volunteer Compound
 - a. Expected attendance: 1000 per day.
 - b. Specs: 10x10 tent, cooling fans, thermometers and hand sanitizing stations.
- 4. Hayden Bridge Underpass
 - a. Expected attendance: 500 per day.
 - b. Specs: 10x10 tent, cooling fans, thermometers and hand sanitizing stations.
- 5. Clubhouse Parking Lot
 - a. Expected attendance: 250 per day.
 - b. Specs: 10x10 tent, cooling fans, thermometers and hand sanitizing stations.
- 6. Fairmont Princess Entrance
 - a. Expected attendance: 500 per day.
 - b. Specs: 10x10 tent, cooling fans, thermometers and hand sanitizing stations.
- 7. West Warehouse off Scottsdale Rd.
 - a. Expected attendance: 200 per day.
 - b. Specs: 10x10 tent, cooling fans, thermometers and hand sanitizing stations.
- 8. Lot 4 Pro-Am Parking (Monday and Wednesday only)
 - a. Expected attendance: 112 / 104 per day.
 - b. Specs: 10x10 tent, cooling fans, thermometers and hand sanitizing stations.



PPE PROTOCOL DESCRIPTION

- Face Coverings, Masks and Full Face Shields- Approved face coverings will be required when
 onsite at the WMPO, covering both the nose and mouth. The following are NOT approved as face
 coverings: masks with vents, valves, mesh, lace or mouth/nose half face shields. Masks will be
 made available at the Main Entrance and on course venues.
- 2. Sanitizers- Hand sanitizer bottle containing a minimum of 70% of alcohol, will be provided for all staff and volunteers to utilize during the week. 350 stationary hand sanitizer units will be placed at each entrance and throughout the golf course and in high touch surface locations. All units are non-touch and sanitizer dispenses when a hand is placed underneath.
- 3. Sterilization- All venues and equipment will include a sterilization protocol that will ensure that all public areas are routinely cleaned throughout the duration of the event. All cleaning staff will receive information of the proper tools and techniques for cleaning and disinfecting procedures.
- 4. Washing Hands- All staff and patrons will be reminded to routinely wash their hands throughout the property with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- 5. Thermal Temperature Readers- Temperature readers will be at each of the tournament entrances and activated to capture the temperatures of all who enter the property. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or above will be sent to the quarantine tent and will not be permitted entrance.
- 6. Gloves- All service staff will be required to wear gloves and routinely change them at all times while working at their assigned location. Gloves should be put on after the face covering.
- 7. Cashless POS- To help prevent the spread of germs, the WMPO will be cash free at all points of sale. This includes food, beverage and merchandise locations.
- 8. Social Distancing- At all points of entry and all points of commerce (merchandise and concessions) attending patrons will be required to maintain 6-feet of separation.
- Credential Monitoring- For all onsite venues/concessions and other popular gathering areas will be monitored by security and/or volunteers with a maximum capacity level implemented and enforced.
- 10. The WMPO reserves the right to remove any volunteer, staff or patron that is not following the health and safety protocols.



MEDICAL PLAN

- Medical Committee Led by Dr. Tony Petelin, Health and Safety Chairman.
- Thermal Scanning Conducted at all entrances and to everyone on property through noncontact thermal temperature readers.
- Additional Screening In addition to thermal scanning, there will be widespread signage
 throughout the main entrance of screening questions. Signage will also indicate that any spectator
 experiencing any active COVID-19 symptoms will be prohibited from entry.
- First Aid / Medical Attention Scottsdale Fire will attend to all medical needs onsite.
- Face Coverings, Masks and Full Face Shields Masks will be required for all while onsite for the 2021 WMPO. A mask will be provided at entrances and venues throughout the course. The following are NOT approved as face coverings: masks with vents, valves, mesh, lace or mouth/nose half face shields. Wearing masks or shields covering the nose and mouth will be enforced while on course unless the individual is actively eating or drinking.
- Face coverings will be made available at the Entrance, 16th Hole Venue, Clubhouse and all Concessions areas.

CREDENTIAL MONITORING AND VENUE OPERATIONS

- Entrance Operations Each entrance will be monitored by attendants who will be provided the proper PPE. All credentials with barcodes will be scanned (touchless) at the main entrance. Hospitality customers will be waived through upon visual confirmation of credential by the attendant (touchless) and are scanned at hospitality venue via RFID portals (touchless).
- Venue Operations All venues will be monitored by volunteers to ensure the number of guests per venue established capacity limitations are strictly followed. Each venue will be monitored by entrance attendants who will be provided the proper PPE. Entrance attendants will either direct patrons to scan their hospitality wristband at RFID portals (touchless) or use a mobile reader to scan credentials of event staff (touchless). Each venue will be equipped with sanitizer dispensers and will be sanitized throughout the day including doors, tables, chairs, etc.



HOSPITALITY VENUES

Clubhouse

- o Consists of tables that seat four or ten guests that are spread out across the Clubhouse lawn.
- o Approved masks or shields will be required unless actively eating or drinking.
- ProEm Security, Volunteer Security and Host Organization will monitor and enforce face covering requirement.
- Masks will be made available at the venue, should anyone need a replacement if lost, damaged etc.

• 16th Hole

- First two rows are tip up seating where masks are mandatory at all times. No consumption of food and beverage will be allowed in the first two rows.
 - Household groups may sit together.
 - Unrelated groups/individuals should social distance.
- The 16th Hole Venue will be broken up into four zones. Guests are required to stay in their dedicated zone.
- Each of the four (4) zones has its own dedicated entry and exit.
- Masks are required throughout the rest of the hospitality venue unless actively eating or drinking.
- ProEm Security, Volunteer Security and Host Organization will monitor and enforce face covering requirement and social distancing measures.
- Masks will be made available at the venue, should anyone need a replacement if lost, damaged etc.



- In addition to carts being sanitized each night, sanitizing wipes will be added to each cart.
- Concession stands will be a part of Waste Management's restroom sanitization loop and will be sanitized on an hourly basis.

Covid 19 Health and Safety

People:

Temperature Checks

• All Levy team members will be required to have their temperature taken upon arrival.

Health Questionnaire

• All Levy team members will be required to complete a health questionnaire upon arrival.

Training

 All Levy team members are required to complete Safe Return to Work Training upon their first shift back to work. All Levy Golf Managers have completed this training already and all other team members will complete training prior to the PGA Championship.

Food Service:

Service Ware & Utensils

- Plastic, single-use cutlery and napkins will be provided to each guest.
- No straws will be provided.
- All cups will have lids and be placed using gloves prior to handing to guest.

Condiments

 All condiments will be pre-packaged and served to each guest by a Levy team member wearing gloves.

Beverage

• All water, soda and sports drinks will be packaged.

Tables

All service tables will be non-porous, wipe-able surfaces.

· Menu Engineering

- All food items will be presented in a covered state with boxed, wrapped or hinged vehicles.
- Food Display: Cold food items will be displayed in a refrigerated display case while hot food items will be kept at the proper temperature via a hot box.

Health and Safety

PPE

- Gloves: All Levy team members handling food will be required to wear gloves. Gloves must be rotated every 30 min and before/after food handling.
- Masks: All Levy team members will be required to wear masks during prep, service and moving through venue.

• Sanitation:

- Sanitation Wipes & Bottles: Surface areas will be wiped down frequently. Hand washing will be required as part of previous protocols and hand sanitizer will be available as well.
- Handwashing: Portable sinks will be installed directly behind all service areas and will continue to be used in all kitchens and pantries. Additional portable handwash setups which include: Insulated
- Container with hands-free spigot, hand soap, paper towel, waste container and garbage can will be located at action stations and in-service areas for staff.
- Cleaning: All surface areas will be cleaned frequently, and a thorough cleaning will take place following each service.

Signage

- Line Spacing: Floor & wall stickers will be installed indicating line operations and spacing.
- Sanitation Signage: Installed front of house and back of house.



WHAT WE ARE DOING

TO HELP PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19.



SANITATION

- Mandatory wearing of non-latex gloves at all times and replacing gloves every time a different task will be performed.
- . Mandatory handwashing every 20-30 minutes, every time gloves or protective gear are changed, and tasks require relocating to another work area/station.
- . Mandatory "social distancing" that keeps all team members at least six feet apart.



THE WORKPLACE

- Remote working for all team members not required for on-site food production, delivery and food service.
- . Suspension of all work-related travel other than food delivery and service.
- Activation of three 8-hour shifts.
 Seven hours production work, with 8th hour for cleaning and sanitizing affected areas, prior to next crew's arrival.



FACILITY PROCEDURES

- . Installation of mobile sanitation stations throughout our facilities.
- . Receipt of all product deliveries through a dedicated single door requiring team member to unlock from the inside.
- Limited handling of food packaging and materials, pulling and opening sealed container of products only as needed.



DIAGNOSISPROTOCOL

- . Health screening of every person entering our facilities including temperature checks and health questionnaires, with results logged on daily shift sheets requiring a manager's signature.
- . Periodic temperature checks throughout team member's shifts.
- . Delivering information regularly to our team members via internal 'M' App.

GENERAL CHECK IN PROCEDURES

- Park in the front parking lot or on 28th Street. The gate is closed to staff parking.

 Please be sensitive to our neighbors, and only park in spaces adjacent to our building.
- The break room door is the only way in and out of the building other than for breaks.
- Only 1 person will be checked in at a time so please wait your turn.
- Chairs will be set-up outside the break room for you to use while you wait to be checked in.

CHECK-IN 8:00AM-9:00AM

- Follow all general check in procedures.
- Someone will be in the protocol room / old break room to check you in.
- Clock in while you wait to be checked in.

CHECK-IN BEFORE 8:00AM OR AFTER 9:00AM

- Follow all general check in procedures.
- Please arrive to your shift no earlier than 15 minutes before.
- Ring the bell and wait for a staff member to arrive to check you in.
- Clock in while you wait to be checked in.

CHECKING IN PROCESS

- You will be asked to wash your hands when entering.
- We will ask every "M" Rebel 4 question about how they feel and recent contact.
- We will take everyone's temperature using a thermal "no touch" thermometer.
- After finishing the process, you will may be issued gloves and a mask.

 If you have been issued a cloth mask, you are expected to bring it to each shift.
- This is YOUR mask and should be part of your uniform each day.

WHILE WORKING YOUR SHIFT

- If you have a single desk/office space you may take your mask off while alone. Masks are to be worn any time you leave your desk or office. This includes trips to the copier or restroom.
- Masks are to be worm at all times if you are working in a shared office, kitchen/warehouse area.
- Wash your hands every 20-30 minutes, after bathroom use, eating or when changing tasks.
- If you feel any symptoms during your shift please CALL your supervisor to discuss. Do not walk around looking for someone.
- Please carry your own knives, pens, markers and highlighters. We are not sharing anything.
- When you're assigned an area stay in that area and do not "visit" other areas.
- 6 FOOT SOCIAL DISTANCING WILL BE CONSTANTLY MAINTAINED

WHILE WORKING YOUR SHIFT

- Breaks will be provided as per employment regulations
 - * The break area facilities at the MCK has been moved to the warehouse. You may use the microwave, coffee machine, water dispenser, and fridge in this area.
 - * The break areas in the admin offices are available to the admin teams.
 - Do not use these areas to socialize.
 - 6 feet must be maintained which limits the number of people who can use the areas at the same time.
 - * There will be no meals provided. You may bring a meal for eating at your workstation or in an area designated by your supervisor.
 - * Refrigerators will be cleaned, and any remaining items removed nightly.
- There will be no smoke breaks during your shift.
 - * The CDC has found that second hand smoke is a risk factor for susceptibility to viruses including Covid-19. The M Culinary properties are smoke free property during this crisis.

OFFICE SANITATION

- Office employees are responsible for cleaning/sanitizing their workstation, desk phone and cell phone at the beginning of their shift daily. We will be providing anti-microbial wipes for your use while at the MCK.
 - * We encourage you to also clean your mouse/keyboard daily.
 - * Do not use anti-microbial wipes on your computer screen or monitors.

OFF-SITE EVENT PROTOCOLS

- The captain/manager of each off-site event will have a thermometer and will follow the off-site protocols we have in place, which are similar to these protocols.
- If you checked into the MCK on the same day as an off-site event you do not need to re-check in when arriving a the event.

REMINDER

- Immediately let your manager know if you have been in contact with someone who has tested positive.
