Hello Clarissa and Company,

Your occupant numbers of 8,000 total with 2,000 in VIP are acceptable to the SFD.

Reference the attached marked up site plan dated 10.29.2025.

Inside Stadium Field GA Section:

- 1) Ramp shall be made ADA compliant.
 - a. SFD is not approving structural stability for any ramp and/or stairs.
- 2) Exit stair 6 (adj. to ramp) is the only viable existing exit through bleacher section.
 - a. Use EXIT banner for this stair exit
- 3) Exit Stairs numbered 1, 2, and 3 are three sets of 60" wide stairs.
- 4) Exit Stairs numbered 4 and 5 are four sets of 60" wide stairs.
- 5) Maintenance Tunnel shall remain open when field is occupied, and mark location with an EXIT banner placed at least 7' above ground level to bottom of banner.

Inside Stadium Field VIP Section:

- 1) Relocate Main Entrance to VIP section closer to the warning track.
 - a. This entrance shall be at least 120" wide.
- 2) Relocate the Emergency Exit Gate 1 in Bike Rack fencing from the warning track to the west, closer to FOH.
 - a. This EE Gate 1 shall be at least 120" wide and swing into the GA section.
 - b. Use an EXIT banner to mark EE Gate 1.
- 3) Temporary Fencing from Stage Right to VIP Bar to extend down to 1st base line bleachers.
 - a. Use one Emergency Exit aka EE Gate 2.
 - b. This EE Gate 2 shall be at least 72" wide and swing in direction of egress (towards bleachers).
 - c. Mark this EE Gate 2 location with an EXIT Flag.
 - d. Note: Gate near VIP Bar is not and Emergency Exit.
- 4) Temporary Fencing from Stage Left to bleachers shall not have an Emergency Exit Gate.
 - a. If an access gate is desired, it shall remain unmarked.
- 5) Charro Tunnel Exit shall remain open when field is occupied.
 - a. Mark this tunnel exit with an EXIT banner placed at least 7' above ground level to bottom of banner.
 - b. Use an Exit Flag and/or Exit banner on lawn, to be seen while exiting tunnel east, directing public north along 1st base line to Exit Gate marked with an Exit Flag.
- 6) Exit Stairs 1 and 2 lead into bleacher section.
 - a. Mark general location with an Exit Flag and mark each Exit Stair with an Exit banner.
 - b. Use an Exit banner OR Exit Flag at bleacher vomitory for directing egress.

Outside Stadium Field:

- 1) Use Exit Flags at 5 Exit Gate locations starting on concourse near ramp, moving north and east to Maintenance tunnel exit. 6th Exit Flag at concrete stairs leading down to Exit Gates southeast of maintenance yard. 7th Exit Flag at south end of Charro Lodge. 8th Exit Flag and/or banner located outside Charro tunnel directing public north to Exit Flag 9. Exit Flag 9 is located at Exit Gate leading to 75th St, as seen from Exit Flag / banner 8.
- 2) Use Exit Banner at Exit Gate located at Main Entrance fencing corral. This Exit Gate needs to be as large as possible, min. 16' wide and swing outward.

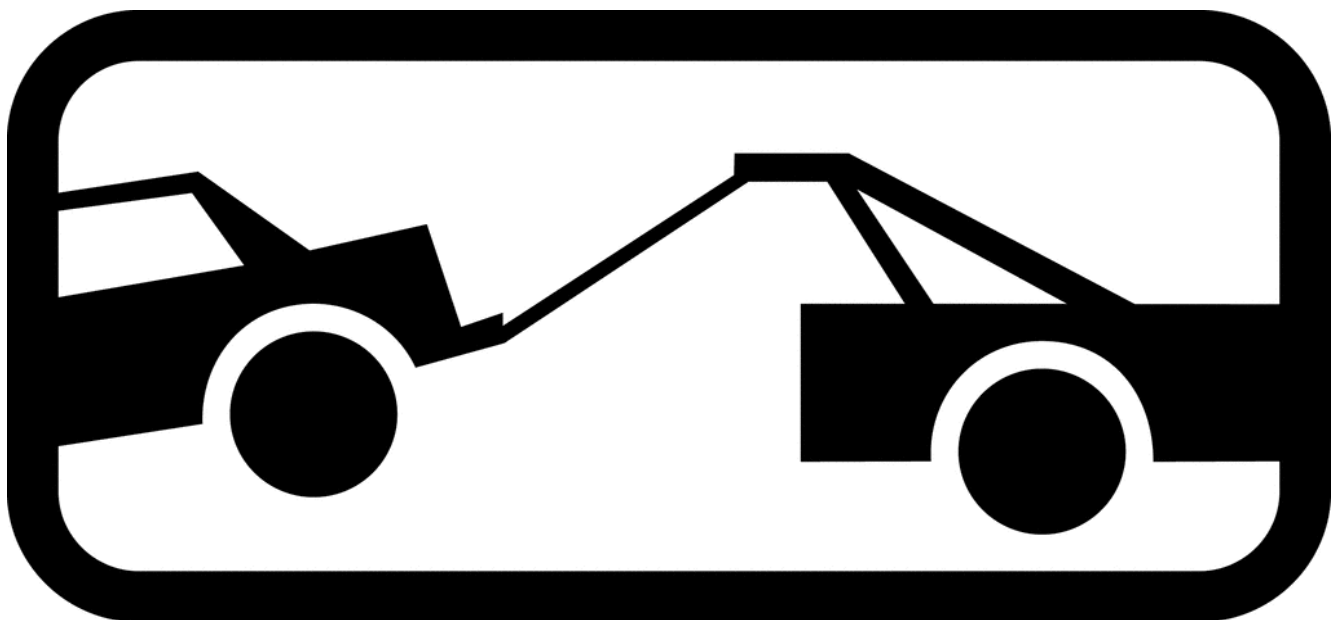

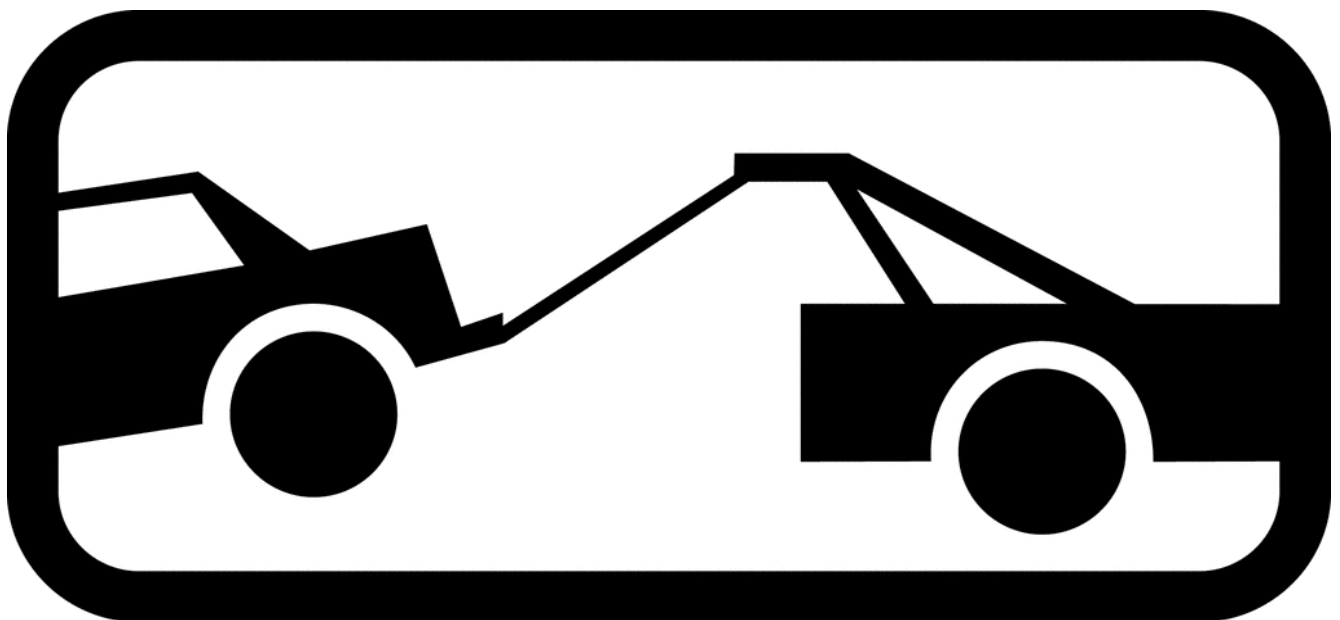

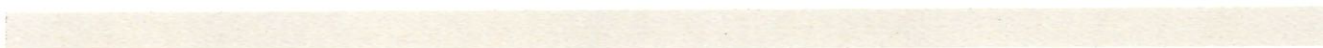
