
- Any runners who do not pass E. Earll heading north on N. Scottsdale Road by 9:50am will be directed to make a u-turn at that location and continue to complete the course.
- This cut off will eliminate 1.5 miles from the course and ensure we stay on schedule for the northern end of the Scottsdale portion of the course road reopening.


