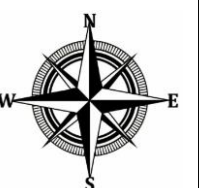

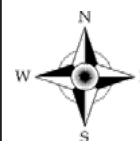

Hi Cheryl,

Arizona Equine Rescue provides technical rescue and recovery animal resources under NAEP standards and FEMA compliant standards. During parades we bring a licensed veterinarian to perform all medical and euthanasia needs while our team manages safety, accident, and transport of livestock to medical facilities. We monitor pedestrian and vehicle traffic around horses to maintain safe practices and distances, we monitor fractious horses and medically sedate as required, we address injuries, we help with horses down in trailers or on the street, we work with police and fire where human injuries are concurrent with an animal accident, and if there is an injured animal during the parade we are called forward to move the animal onto our trailer to take off route for treatment. All horse related emergencies can be sent thru the ops channel of the parade radio or police can call my cell at 602.538.0416. Our trained responders monitor staging, destaging and walk with entries through the parade route and are clearly visible with blue shirts that say large animal emergency response on the back in the same format as fire.

Hello Travis-

As discussed earlier today, the access for the hotel during [Parada del Sol parade](#) event activation will be the same as last year, entering/exiting from Marshall Way, using the alley located north of the hotel, going north/south through the Buca di Beppo parking lot drive aisle, and entering/exiting from 2nd Street directly into the garage.

This requires approval from Buca to allow vehicles to go through their parking lot from 7a-1p on Sat. Feb. 1st, two hotel staff to assist with managing garage access both in and out, and placing two signs that state "Hotel Access Only" and the east and west ends of the alley to help with directing motorists. The city will provide a security staff at Marshall / alley to help monitor and direct motorists and an officer at 2nd Street / Buca driveway to assist with hotel guest vehicles needing access in or out during the parade hours while the street is closed. Motorists that go south on Marshall Way from Main that are not hotel guests will be directed west to use the city parking garage or return to Goldwater.

Can you reach out to the GM or property owner for Buca de Beppo to inquire if they are okay with the limited hotel access through their property for that morning? If so, can you email me the individual's name/date you spoke with to note who supported the limited use?

Let me know if any other concerns arise.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND SELECTION:

- Entries/applicants are all subject to approval by Parade Organizers
- Entries are encouraged to dress Western
- All entries must be at their designated line-up areas and report to Parade Staging Committee by 7:30 am. Unless otherwise instructed by Parade Officials.
- The Parade participants must be "family friendly", appropriate to be seen by all ages.
- No entry will be entered into the parade whose purpose is to campaign for any office, promote any partisan political position or ballot proposal.
- Judging of all entries will take place during the Parade. No one will be eligible for parade awards unless properly positioned prior to the start of the parade.

ENTRY APPLICATION FORM:

- The entry application form must be completed and signed with the understanding of the general rules and guidelines. It must include payment if applicable
- The parade organizers reserve the right to reject any application or entry at any time
- All applications must come with 75 word or less Script
- Staging instructions will be emailed on or before January 29th, 2024
- Entry numbers will be given out at check in, morning of the Parade.
- The rules and guidelines are for the safety and quality of the parade. Failure to abide by these rules and guidelines and those presented with the parade information package, may result in the entry's removal from the parade
- . Any advertising that includes the name of a business is considered a "commercial entry" and is subject to the "commercial entry fees."
- Under the Internal Revenue Code, all section 501(c)(3) organizations are absolutely prohibited from directly or indirectly participating in, or intervening in, any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for elective public office.

THIS IS A FORWARD MOTION PARADE:

- All entries are required to maintain a continuous forward motion during the parade. **No stopping**

NO TOSSING CANDY OR FAVORS:

- Nothing can be tossed from the parade route or curbside due to liability policies set forth by the parade insurance company and the City. NO handouts of food items or merchandise without prior authorization from the organizers.

IDENTIFICATION SIGNS:

- Identification banners are encouraged for entries in the parade
- Signs must be for identification purpose only and not as a political statement

CANCELLATION POLICY:

- Only a significant act of nature will cancel the parade, of which all units would be notified
- If, for some unforeseen reason, your unit is not able to participate in the parade after being accepted, you must contact the parade staff, prior to the parade date, as soon as possible
- Entries absent on parade day without proper notification may not receive future invitations
- **Entry Fees are not refundable.** If for any reason an entry is not accepted into the line-up, fees will be returned. Once accepted into the line-up, fees are not refundable

PERFORMING GROUPS(dancing horses, dancers, baton twirlers, etc.):

- Please try and keep moving along the route. This is a forward moving parade
- Please obey Parade Officials Instructions along the route
- Entries requiring vehicles to carry sound systems must notify parade organizers on the application.
- Drill / Dance routines must be choreographed for forward motion. No stopping to perform
- All flags or colors must be rolled until the line of march has been reached (parade's starting line)
- All entries must follow De Staging Instructions that will be emailed before Parade day.

FLOATS:

- Floats cannot exceed 50 feet in length (including tow vehicle), 13 feet in height and 10 feet wide.
- All vehicles must be properly insured and drivers must have a valid drivers license
- NO loose Balloons. Balloon arches are permitted as long as they are secured.
- Vehicle and float drivers must be able to have a clear view of the front of the vehicle
- Floats must be constructed of fire-safe materials and must carry a fire extinguisher
- Appropriate area for vehicle exhaust must be designed into the float/unit
- All Entries must follow De Staging Instructions that will be emailed before Parade Day.

VEHICLES:

- Drivers must be able to have a clear view of the front of the vehicle
- **All vehicles must be properly insured and drivers must have a valid drivers license. (These will be checked on the day of the parade, during Staging)**

EQUESTRIANS/ANIMALS:

- **ALL HORSES SHALL BE ATENDED PRIOR TO AND AFTER EVENT. ABSOLUTELY NO HORSES SHALL BE LEFT UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME DURING STAGING and at PARADE AND TRAILS END FESTIVAL.**
- Any animal deemed unsafe in the parade will be removed
- All Parade entries shall exhibit proper disposition and control of all animals in a parade environment.
- Children under the age of 6 years will not be permitted to ride horseback.
- All light and heavy horse hitches shall have an assistant in the front seat of the wagon.
- Any hitches in excess of two horses shall have at least (1) assistant on the ground.
- All children ages 6 to 12 on horses, MUST wear safety helmets & MUST MEET ASTM SEI safety standards. Bike Helmets are NOT permitted.
- **ANIMALS MUST BE NOTED ON FORM:** If you are bringing animals with your unit, they must be identified on the Parade Entry Form. Horses, dogs, cows, reptiles, and any other wild or domestic animals shall not be in the parade without specific written approval by the Parade Committee. **All entrants with animals must submit proof that there is insurance in place to cover the animal's activity**
- **Arizona Equine Rescue Organization will be onsite**

SPECIAL GUESTS / DIGNITARIES:

- **ELECTION/ISSUE CAMPAIGNING:** NO participant may advocate, oppose or depict any political, religious, social or other ballot or political issue or candidate in the parade. The Scottsdale Parada del Sol Parade will not permit itself to be used as a platform or advertising vehicle for any candidate or issue. No election signs, themes, or colors may be displayed. Units discovered to have political advertising, or to be distributing political advertising along the route, will be removed from the line-up. Currently serving elected officials who represent the City of Scottsdale area will be invited to ride in the parade. They may not campaign for re-election, or for another office, nor may they display or distribute electioneering materials or election colors or shirts on the Parade Route.

PARTICIPANT AGE RESTRICTIONS:

- There must be a least one adult escort for every six children under the age of 13 years
- Young children riding on a float must have adult supervision with and around them

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SAFE. *Breaking any of the following safety protocols will subject units to immediate removal from the Parade.* Units removed from the parade will not be permitted into the parade line up the following year.

- **DO NOT USE AIR HORNS.** Air horns may not be used by any unit in the parade.
- **DO NOT THROW CANDY.** Throwing of any candy, merchandise or other items is prohibited. Items must be handed to spectators, **if we see you throwing items you may be removed from the parade.**
- **DO NOT HAND OUT** food items or merchandise along the parade route without prior authorization
- **DO NOT** proceed in an unsafe manner.
- **DO NOT** interfere in any way with other units.
- **Comply with ALL Parade Official** requests.
- **DO NOT** drink any alcoholic beverages in the staging area, or along the route. **ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED** in parade.
- **DO NOT** Jump on or OFF any moving float or vehicle.
- **No open flames, fireworks, pyrotechnics, etc.** are permitted in the parade without proper approvals and permits from the Fire Department.
- **Scottsdale City Ordinance does not permit the discharge of firearms within city limits. ALL GUNS MUST BE EMPTY! Anyone violating this rule will subject themselves to arrest by the Scottsdale Police Department.**

ALL ENTRIES SHALL OBTAIN AND PROVIDE A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE WITHOUT DEMAND. A MINIMUM \$1,000,000.00 GENERAL LIABILITY POLICY IS REQUIRED TO COVER YOUR GROUPS' PARTICIPATION IN THE PARADE. Arizona Revised Statutes ARS 12-553

12-553. Limited liability of equine owners and owners of equine facilities

A. An equine owner or an agent of an equine owner who regardless of consideration allows another person to take control of an equine is not liable for an injury to or the death of the person if:

- 1. The person has taken control of the equine from the owner or agent when the injury or death occurs.**
- 2. The person or the parent or legal guardian of the person if the person is under eighteen years of age has signed a release before taking control of the equine.**
- 3. The owner or agent has properly installed suitable tack or equipment, or the person has personally tacked the equine with tack the person owned, leased or borrowed. If the person has personally tacked the equine, the person assumes full responsibility for the suitability, installation and condition of the tack.**
- 4. The owner or agent assigns the person to a suitable equine based on a reasonable interpretation of the person's representation of his skills, health and experience with and knowledge of equines.**

B. Subsection A does not apply to an equine owner or agent of the equine owner who is grossly negligent or commits willful, wanton or intentional acts or omissions.

C. An owner, lessor or agent of any riding stable, rodeo ground, training or boarding stable or other private property that is used by a rider or handler of an equine with or without the owner's permission is not liable for injury to or death of the equine or the rider or handler.

D. Subsection C does not apply to an owner, lessor or agent of any riding stable, rodeo ground, training or boarding stable or other private property that is used by a rider or handler of an equine if either of the following applies:

- 1. The owner, lessor or agent knows or should know that a hazardous condition exists, and the owner, lessor or agent fails to disclose the hazardous condition to a rider or handler of an equine.**
- 2. The owner, lessor or agent is grossly negligent or commits willful, wanton or intentional acts or omissions.**

E. As used in this section:

- 1. "Equine" means a horse, pony, mule, donkey or ass.**
- 2. "Release" means a document that a person signs before taking control of an equine from the owner or owner's agent and that acknowledges that the person is aware of the inherent risks associated with equine activities, is willing and able to accept full responsibility for his own safety and welfare and releases the equine owner or agent from liability unless the equine owner or agent is grossly negligent or commits willful, wanton or intentional acts or omissions.**
